Spring Concert Featuring Sungpil Kim, Winner of this year's International Young Artists Concert

Sunday, March 27, 2011, 3 p.m. **Reception for Sungpil Kim following concert**

The Jefferson Symphony Orchestra (JSO) will be presenting their Spring Concert featuring Guest Artist, Sungpil Kim.

The competition was an all-day event on Saturday, January 8, 2011, at the Arvada Center for the Arts and Humanities, co-sponsor. The winners performed in a 7:30 p.m. recital.

11 finalists from six different countries competed for a \$5,000 annuity to the first-place winner, as well as cash prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners. The Golden Civic Foundation, Wilmot Charitable Trust, Fine Arts Foundation, Scientific & Cultural Facilities District, Jacques and Janet Robertson, and Kinder Morgan helped underwrite this competition.

Kim will be performing Chopin's Piano Concerto No. 1 in E minor, Op. 11

Kim is from Korea. He attended Juilliard Pre-college 2003-2007, studying with Martin Canin. A recipient of *The Arabella Leith Symington Griswold Piano Scholarship* and *Marion Savage Rosette Piano Scholarship*, Sungpil Kim, now a senior at Peabody Institute of the Johns Hopkins University, has been studying with Yong Hi Moon since 2007.
